

The following are **NOT** ALLOWED at the Elementary District Fair.

- ⊘ Dead animals
- ⊘ Mold, bacteria, or virus projects. Only pictures of mold are allowable.
- ⊘ Living animal projects without **Approval Forms**
- ⊘ Human subject projects without **Approval Forms**
- ⊘ Preserved specimens, body parts, taxidermy, dissections or autopsy photos
- ⊘ Any solid, liquid, or gas chemical or compound samples
- ⊘ Food – either human or animal
- ⊘ Weapons of any kind, any sharp items or edges
- ⊘ Glassware including containers containing liquids - have ALL students remove any glass items from their displays.
- ⊘ Any medicines, vitamins, poisons (including plants), or drugs of any kind
- ⊘ Flammable or combustible substances, candles, lamps, burners, or other heating devices
- ⊘ Project board over 36" tall by 48" wide
- ⊘ Any materials deemed unsafe or inappropriate by the District Fair
- ⊘ Any awards, medals, business cards. Even though these are impressive, they give an unfair advantage over other students
- ⊘ Chemical substances of any kind
- ⊘ Projects that require electrical outlet – NO ELECTRICITY will be available due to lack of space and safety.

The Elementary District Fair Committee reserves the right to disqualify any project considered unsafe or inappropriate from judging and remove it from public display.

Students, parents, and teachers are responsible for checking their display boards before registering them into the District Fair competition to make sure they comply with the rules and have all the appropriate forms needed for certification.
