I assure you my staff is here to support and help students along, with this new style of on-line learning. Teachers have been working hard on setting up their Canvas pages, learning how to do Zoom conference calls, as well as creating Google voice numbers so you can talk to them directly. Our office phone will still be answered by our wonderful school secretary Miss Skylar Monday through Friday 8 am to 4pm. She will take a message and get it to the appropriate person. If you get the voicemail please leave a message and she will call you back as she can only receive one call at a time using Google voice. Teacher teams are working together to make sure you hear from one of the teachers on the team between the hours of 8 am to 8 pm Monday through Friday. Our website has all emails for you to use directly and you can continue to seek help through your teacher's normal digital communication such as Remind, Class DOJO or Bloomz app. Our website has contact information for technical support if you are struggling to get in your child's MyPascoConnect account or if you struggle with the Funky password needed. Lastly, remember that tomorrow is pick up day at the school if your child needs to borrow a device to use. Pre-K through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade can drive through the car loop from 1:30 to 3 p.m. and will be given an ipad, a charger as well as directions to get started. Intermediate families can come through the loop from 3:00 o'clock to 4:30 pm.
