COVID updates/IMPORTANT Request

- As we return from lots of family gatherings I need to ask you all a huge favor! Deer Park has been fortunate in not having to quarantine entire classes because families erred on the side of caution and we truly appreciate this! Please self-quarantine your children if any of the following occur. Call and ask to speak to our Clinic and someone will give you next steps.
 - Anyone in the immediate family is Covid positive
 - If your family was exposed/close contact to anyone Covid positive
 - Your children are sick with Covid like symptoms
- We will continue to provide school work, AND absences once confirmed due to Covid, are excused
- Did you know you **CANNOT TEST OUT OF QUARANTINE** WHEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WHO IS COVID POSITIVE? Even with a negative test result, you must monitor yourself for COVID-19 symptoms and self-quarantine for 14 days after you were exposed to a positive case. It is possible to have a negative test on Day 6 and become symptomatic a few days later.

Free/Reduced Lunch Application- Must Do

• Currently, all students are eligible to receive free breakfast and lunch, regardless of their eligibility status. Even so, we strongly encourage you to complete a new meal application if your household qualifies. In addition to meal benefits, students eligible for free or reduced-price meals can receive free or discounted testing fees, camp registrations, high-speed internet, and other benefits. Schools also receive a portion of their funding based off the percentage of students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals based off their household meal application, regardless of whether that student is attending mySchoolOnline or in person.
